

## **Job Description: Art Support Sessional Worker**

**Job Title:** Art Support Sessional Worker

**Responsible to:** Young people's Substance Misuse Senior Practitioner/Arts Lead

**Hours:** Variable

**Job purpose:** As an Art Sessional Worker you will support the Young Peoples Substance Misuse Service (YPSMS) Senior Practitioner in the planning and delivery of a variety of art sessions and activities that support young people to achieve their Arts Award Qualification with the Royal Borough of Greenwich Children's Services. This includes listening to young people's ideas to design art sessions, the development of the art group around their creative needs, choices and aspirations. You will involve young people in art sessions that are stimulating, and enjoyable, while promoting their wellbeing and encouraging them to take an active role in their community. You will be responsible for supporting young people, gather evidence and build their portfolio towards an Arts Award Moderation.

### **Responsibilities**

- To assist the YPSMS Senior Practitioner with the planning and delivering of art sessions, trips, and a variety of other appropriate social and educational art activities for young people.
- To support the Senior Practitioner in the evidence gathering, portfolio building, and the moderation process of young peoples Arts Award qualifications.
- To work positively with colleagues, and to follow the lead of the YPSMS Senior Practitioner, to ensure a high-quality group experience for all young people.
- To set up and help run the art sessions together with the YPSMS Senior Practitioner and other staff and volunteers.
- To support young people during sessions and encourage their creative process and creative confidence.
- To clear up and clean after sessions, leaving the space safe and tidy.
- To participate in the evaluation of sessions.
- To always work within the Royal Borough of Greenwich policies and procedures including Equality & Diversity, Safeguarding and Health and Safety Policies.
- To maintain confidentiality about young people and to safeguard young people in line with the RBG safeguarding policy.
- To contribute to effective teamwork amongst other staff and volunteers.
- To liaise appropriately with parents, carers and other professionals.
